Guidelines for posters

The purpose of this document is to advise poster presenters on the required format when preparing their posters for this conference. Please follow the instructions below.

1. Language

Your poster must be **in English**, the official language of the conference.

2. Format

POSTER BOARDS

Each author will be attributed a poster board 125 cm (height) x 95 cm (width).

Poster presenters are recommended to create their poster in A0 size which corresponds to 841mm (width) x 1,189mm (height).

Each board will be numbered on the upper left hand corner.

Be sure to display your poster on the board with the number given to your poster in the pocket programme inserted in your conference bag.

Material for attaching your poster will be provided by the organisers.

CONTENT

Your poster (text, figures, photos) should be readable from a distance of 1.5 m.

Be simple and direct in your poster presentation.

Use short phrases and bullet points. Avoid long narrative paragraphs.

The posters should be organised to include the following elements:

- **Overview:** a succinct summary of the purpose, methods and results. Use phrases rather than sentences in a simple outline format. Place in the upper left section of the poster.
- **Introduction:** a concise statement of the objective and background of the work.
- **Methods:** description of the apparatus, chemistry, samples, materials, etc. in some (but not overwhelming) details.
- **Results:** graphs, spectra, pictures, etc., (minimum of text) illustrating the nature of the results.
- **Conclusions:** concise statement of the findings (positive, as well as negative), indicating future research directions.

HANDOUTS

Authors are encouraged to provide handouts, e.g., preprints or copies of poster.

Authors are expected to be present next to their poster during the poster session.
